A well trained and informed Cultural Resource Monitor acts as a liaison between tribal communities, developers, and public agencies. Their role is to ensure that tribal cultural resources are respected and protected from any unforeseen or unmitigated damage. This training session is FREE for anyone who works for California and Nevada tribal communities especially those working for tribal transportation programs. The number of training participants is limited. Transportation personnel will get priority for registration. See the next page for registration information.

### **TOOLS FOR PROTECTING CULTURAL RESOURCES!**

**This two day training session will be presented on July 26-27, 2010 by a panel of experts. Days one and two of this training session are open to California and Nevada Tribal Transportation Personnel. Day three is reserved for technical assistance for the Viejas tribal community specifically.** Participants will receive a comprehensive training manual and a certificate of completion for this course.

This unique training will provide those who work for tribal communities in California and Nevada with information about federal and state laws and regulations that preserve cultural resources in Indian Country, county resource management protocols, archeological compliance strategies, overview of archeological field work, working with topographic maps and GPS, cultural resource monitor reporting requirements.

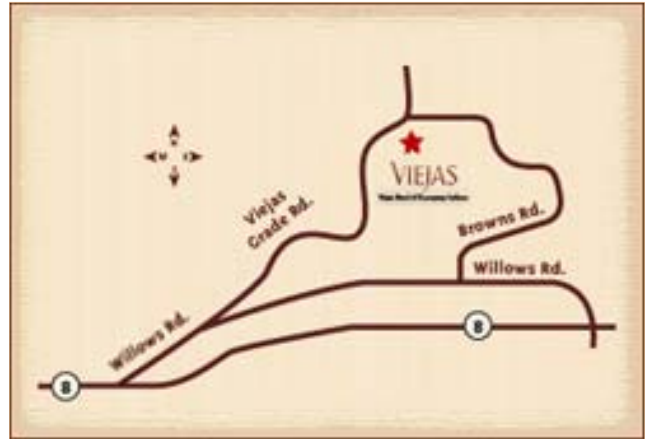
